IMPORTANT INFO:

All Schools must be registered via www.LTA.org.uk/ schools to take part in the competition. Registration is **FREE** for all schools.

- 4 singles, 2 doubles format – only 4 players required for a team
- Localised leagues with local organisers
- Tennis for any standard – majority of teams play in local Division 2 Leagues
- Option to play fixtures at central venues to reduce travel and staff time

EVENTS/ELIGIBILITY:

Year 7 & 8 Boys and Year 7 & 8 Girls:

Players must be in Years 7-8 or born between 1 September 2008 and 31 August 2010.

Year 9 & 10 Boys and Year 9 & 10 Girls:

Players must be in Years 7-10 or born between 1 September 2006 and 31 August 2010.

Format: 4 singles and 2 doubles rubbers (4 players).

Scoring: Each rubber is one set, e.g. 6-4.

Entry Fee: The competition is **FREE** to enter for all schools in England, Scotland and Wales.

Leagues: Teams can enter at Division 1 or Division 2.

League Stage Dates (Summer Term):

League fixtures for both Division 1 and 2 take place in the Summer Term (April-July). Local league organisers set the match dates.

DIVISION 1:

Teams in Division 1 feature students who are more experienced competition players and tennis is one of their main sports. The winner of each Division 1 has the opportunity to play on a regional and national level later in the year.

Division 1 Knockout Stage:

(Division 1 winners only) - September & October

Division 1 Regional Finals:

(4x Central Venues) - 10 & 11 November

Division 1 National Finals:

(Bolton Arena) - 3 & 4 December

DIVISION 2:

The majority of teams compete in Division 2 in a localised league during the summer term only. Players have a limited amount of experience in competition and are of a recreational standard. A rating cap applies at Division 2 to provide more appropriate fixtures for teams involved.

Division 2 Regional Finals:

Division 2 winners qualify for Regional Finals in the autumn term held at a central venues.

Instant email confirmation will be received by the team captain once the team(s) are entered online. Competition team will also email confirmation of entry to teams on Friday 21 January 2022.
