## **INTRODUCTION**

Welcome to the player information pack for the 11U,12U and 14U Lexus Junior National Tennis Championships 2025. This document will provide you with the information you need to enter and compete in the events.

We are incredibly excited about delivering the 11U, 12U and 14U Lexus National Championships in 2025 at Lexus Nottingham Tennis Centre. There will be no format changes for 2025 or eligibility changes for 2025. Please be reminded of the **important changes being made to player eligibility in 2024.** If a player has an ATP/WTA/ITF/TE IPIN the IPIN must show the player appearing as GBR; at the time of acceptance (entry deadline) and throughout the tournament.

The 14U format will be a 'double elimination' format (also known as feed in consolation). For the 11U and 12U main draw in each event will start with a round robin format, with every player playing three matches. The top two players in each box will then progress to compete in a 16-player elimination draw to become the national champion.

The 9U and 10U Grade 1 National Tour is not considered as a National Junior Tennis Championships but will be run alongside the Lexus Junior National Tennis Championships. This National Tour Tournament is the final event of the 2024/25 calendar; the event aims to create an opportunity for the best players in a year group to compete against their peers. Following the success of last year the 10U event will be played with a yellow ball and the 9U event being played with a green ball and on a green court. These enhancements have been made in collaboration with the Performance Team to ensure player development is at the heart of the Performance Competition Calendar. The 9U National Tour will be held indoors and some matches of the 10U National Tour will also be played indoors.

We look forward to receiving your entry and hopefully welcoming you to the Lexus Junior National Tennis Championships & Lexus National Tour 2025.

## **REGULATIONS**

The Lexus Junior National Tennis Championships & Lexus National Tour are staged by the LTA and will be conducted in accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis and LTA Competition Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct.

## PLAYER ELIGIBILITY (NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS ONLY)

To enter and compete in the Lexus LTA Junior National Tennis Championships a player must meet the following criteria:

- A. Player must be a national of Great Britain;
- B. Player **must not** have competed in another closed national championship in the 12 months preceding the Lexus Junior National Tennis Championships;
- C. **NEW for 2025** If a player has an ATP/WTA/ITF/TE IPIN the IPIN must show the player appearing as **GBR**;
- D. Player must not have previously represented any other nation in the Davis Cup or Billie Jean King Cup (formerly Federation Cup) or the Olympic tennis event; and
- E. Player must have an LTA membership number.

## Once the acceptances have been published players will be asked to provide proof of Nationality and date of birth. More details will be sent to the relevant players.

All players must be available for the full duration of the tournament – round robin, elimination and doubles (if entered).

## **AGE GROUP ENTRY RESTRICTIONS**

#### FOR 14U PLAYERS:

Singles & Doubles Players are permitted to enter & compete in the 14U singles and doubles events in August 2025, and the 16U and 18U singles and doubles events in April 2025.

#### FOR 12U PLAYERS:

Singles & Doubles Players are permitted to enter both the 12U and 14U singles events <u>but may only compete in one</u> of these events.

#### FOR 11U PLAYERS:

Singles & Doubles Players are permitted to enter both the 11U and 12U singles events <u>but may only compete in one</u> of these events.

#### FOR 10U PLAYERS:

Singles Players are permitted to enter & compete in both the 10U National Tour and 11U National Championships singles events.

#### FOR 9U PLAYERS:

Singles Players are permitted to enter both the 9U and 10U singles events <u>but may only compete in one of</u> <u>these events</u>.



#### Doubles

Players are permitted to enter multiple doubles events but can only compete in one doubles event. They can choose which doubles event they can compete in irrespective of which singles event they compete in e.g. a player can compete in the 12U singles event and the 14U doubles event.

## **ENTRY INFORMATION**

## How To Enter – Singles

• Players must enter online prior to the closing deadline, using online tournament entry:

Enter the 11U Lexus LTA Junior National Tennis Championships Enter the 12U Lexus LTA Junior National Tennis Championships Enter the 14U Lexus LTA Junior National Tennis Championships Enter the Lexus National Tour - 10U Enter the Lexus National Tour - 9U

- A player **must** ensure that his/her name appears on the entry list before the closing deadline in order to be considered.
- Junior National Tennis Championships Singles entry fee £55.00 National tour events - £37.00 Payment will be taken during the online entry process.
- Players should check their contact details are up to date on their LTA profile as these will be used to send any communication
- If you are experiencing problems entering online please contact the Tournament Director at <u>Nationaltour@LTA.org.uk</u> **BEFORE** the closing deadline. The date and time of the email / telephone call will be considered in any entry disputes. No action can be taken if contact is made after the closing deadline.



## How To Enter – Doubles

- Entry will be possible online when the singles opens and will close at the singles closing deadline.
- Entry will reopen on the day before the singles events start.
- Entry can be made via on-site sign-in at the tournament or by contacting the tournament referee. The entry deadline for the doubles events is 12 noon on the first day of the singles draw (round robin stage).
- Doubles entry fee £22 per player. Payment will be taken on-site. Players will not be entered into the doubles event until their entry fee has been received.

#### Late Entries

- A late entry may not be accepted if he/she would be seeded at the time of making the late entry.
- Late entries will only be accepted if the event is under-subscribed or there are places available on the reserve list.
- Late entries will join the bottom of the reserve list, in order of receipt.
- Should a late entry move to the top of the reserve list **before** the draw is made and a place becomes available, he/she can be accepted into the event, even though at that point, he/she could be seeded.
- <u>After the draw</u> has been made, a late entrant may not be accepted into the event if he/she moves to the top of the reserve list and would be seeded.

#### Wild Cards

The tournament reserves the right to issue up to 1 wild card for every 8 spaces in the draw. Wild cards are spaces in the draw reserved for players who have entered, but would not be accepted through the stated acceptance criteria.

- Wild cards will be awarded in accordance with the LTA Competition Regulations (3.20-3.22) and the LTA Wild Card Policy.
- Wild cards for the 11U, 12U & 14U singles events will ideally published by Thursday 31 July 2025 however the LTA reserve the right to hold the wild cards and issue them at any time up to the draw
- Wild cards for the National Tour 9U & 10U will ideally published by Thursday 31 July 2025 however the LTA reserve the right to hold the wild cards and issue the wild card prior to the draw
- Any wild card spaces not used will be released and the next eligible player will move into the draw.
- Wild cards are awarded on an entirely discretionary basis. Neither the Tournament Team nor the LTA Performance Team will enter into any correspondence as to why a particularly player was (or was not) issued a wild card.



## **ACCEPTANCES**

## Singles Acceptance Criteria – 11U to 14U

- 1. Acceptance is based on a player's LTA combined ranking as at the entry deadline. Where this is equal the players will be drawn by lot, i.e. randomly.
- 2. All eligible players not accepted will be placed on the reserve list.

#### Singles Acceptance Criteria – 90 & 100

- 1. Acceptance is based on a player's LTA recent form as at the entry deadline. Where this is equal the players will be drawn by lot, i.e. randomly.
- 2. All eligible players not accepted will be placed on the reserve list.

#### **Doubles Acceptance Criteria**

Doubles acceptance will give priority to players in the following order

- 1. 2 players in same age group singles main draw
- 2. 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 player in another age group singles main draw
- 3. 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 reserve or non-entered singles player
- 4. 2 reserves or non-entered singles players

Where an event is over-subscribed selections will be made based on the above order of priority and according to:

- 1. Combined domestic age group ranking (using data available at the time the singles draw was made)
- 2. Where pairings are tied, the pair with the highest singles ranked player will take precedence
- 3. By lot where pairs are still tied.

#### Publication of <u>Singles</u> Acceptance Lists

The acceptance list will be published by Thursday 30 July 2025.

#### **Reserves**

- It is the responsibility of reserves to check the website to track their reserve status and acceptance. Prior to the withdrawal deadline reserves will not be contacted by the Tournament Director if a space becomes available.
- A reserve will only be personally contacted by the Tournament Director or Referee after the withdrawal deadline has passed if a space becomes available.
- If a player, including reserves, withdraws after the withdrawal deadline, he/she will incur withdrawal points and the entry fee will be retained with one exception relating to reserves.
- Exception: Reserves may decline an offer to play in the 24 hours prior to the start of the event without incurring withdrawal penalty points, and their entry fee will be refunded.



## **SEEDINGS**

### Seeding criteria for Singles and Doubles – 11U to 14U

- Singles seeding shall be based on the players' LTA Ranking on the date the singles draw is made.
- Doubles seeding shall be based on the players' combined LTA Ranking on the date the Singles draw is made.

#### Seeding criteria for Singles and Doubles – 90 & 100

• Singles seeding shall be based on the players' LTA Recent Form on the date the singles draw is made.
