TOURNAMENT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FOR THE 2023 CINCH CHAMPIONSHIPS: 19 – 25 JUNE 2023

Firstly, thanks to those residents who attended the Resident's Forum in person and virtually, your time was greatly appreciated. The safety and security of all those at and around the cinch Championships is of paramount importance. We work closely with the Metropolitan Police and Council Highways team to ensure appropriate safety and security measures are in place during the tournament, and also to minimise disruption to local residents as much as possible.

The following temporary traffic management arrangements will be in operation between Thursday 4 May and Friday 14 July (Greyhound Road until 19 July). The detailed map shown on the reverse can be found online at www.lta.org.uk/residents-information

- Various parking suspensions will be in place to accommodate the large vehicles in the build and break-down periods, and other parking suspensions will facilitate spectator queuing and access during the tournament (see map legend for the dates each type of suspension will be enforced)
- Large lorries will be escorted into The Queen's Club along Palliser Road against the one-way system on various days between Thursday 4 May and Friday 14 July. The majority occur between 5am to 6am, with some ad-hoc escorts in the afternoons
- The Parking Control hours of operation in sections of Zones D and H (dashed line on map) will be extended to 09:00 – 19:00 from Monday 19 to Sunday 25 June. For more information visit www.lbhf.gov.uk/parking/parking-permits/visitor-permits or call 020 8753 6681
- Palliser Road (between Comeragh Road and Barton Road) will be one-way, northbound, for all traffic from Monday 19 to Sunday 25 June to ease vehicle flow.

On recommendation from the Metropolitan Police, four road closures with physical security measures will be in place from 09:00 – 22:00 from Monday 19 to Sunday 25 June. The measures deployed will be similar to those used last year and will have no impact on pedestrians. The four locations are (solid red and blue lines on the map overleaf):

- Comeragh Road (between the junctions with Gledstones Road and Palliser Road)
- Palliser Road (between the junctions with The Queen's Club and Barton Road)
- Perham Road (between the junctions with Gledstones Road and St Andrew's Road)
- Gledstones Road (between the junctions with Perham Road and Fairholme Road)

We will endeavour to minimise the impact on residents with vehicles and those in adjacent properties, however we ask that you follow this advice, if at all possible:

- Zone D Resident Parking, please retain proof of your address in your vehicle as no physical Zone D permits are issued by the Council. If there are parking spaces available, you will be able to drive through the road closures marked in blue when directed by the security stewards. Unfortunately, residents' visitors will not be able to park within the closures
- The road closures marked in red will not be vehicle accessible at all between 09:00 – 22:00. Therefore, if you need to exit the area, you may need to perform a U-turn to exit via the road closures marked in blue. Traffic stewards will be on hand to assist
- Limit moving your vehicle during the hours of 09:00 – 22:00 if possible, or park outside of the road closure areas if there is space available
- Try not to arrange deliveries during the period 19 – 25 June. However, if you do need to have something delivered, or already have a delivery booked, please email us at residentenquiries@queenstennis.info so the Police can pre-authorise this through the appropriate road closure
- Follow the instructions given by our security stewards at all times. They are there to keep us all safe.

CINCH CHAMPIONSHIPS RESIDENTS' TICKETS

Resident's priority ticket window ran from 21 February to 27 February 2023.

We are delighted that the Resident's Evening Ground Admission offer which entitles residents to complimentary entry on multiple evenings between Monday 19 and Friday 23 June for themselves and one guest is returning for 2023. - The registration period will open at 10am on Tuesday 9 May and closes at 10am on Sunday 18 June
- Admission will be from 4.30pm onwards but it is dependent on safe capacity restrictions within the grounds which may affect the number of entries at any one time
- Entry will operate through the Perham Road Entrance where the stewards will simply scan your ticket and check your proof of residency and ID
- Centre Court Resale tickets will be available to purchase once inside the grounds, payment for these this year will be via credit/debit card.
