Career highlights:

- Has finished in the top 100 of the WTA Rankings every year since 2014.
- Reached the quarter-finals at the Surbiton Trophy in 2022.

- Brengle beat top seed Serena Williams in Auckland 64 67 64 just before Williams went on to win the 2017 Australian Open.

# KATIE BOULTER (GBR) v OLIVIA GADECKI (AUS)

Head to Head: First meeting

## Katie Boulter biography HERE

2023 highlights:

- Boulter kicked off her year by winning the seventh ITF title of her career at the <u>W60</u> <u>Canberra</u> event.
- She was selected to represent Great Britain in their Billie Jean King Cup qualifying tie against France at the Coventry Building Society Arena.
- Boulter blitzed through to the final at the W80 Gifu event where she was beaten in the final by Japan's Himeno Sakatsume, her biggest singles' final to date in her career. Boulter then made it through to another ITF W60 Final a week later, withdrawing due to injury.
- Boulter is currently ranked at No.125 and her best win by ranking this year came against France's Diane Parry (No.111) in qualifying at Indian Wells in March.

### Olivia Gadecki biography HERE

2023 highlights:

- Lost against Priscilla Hon in the Final of the ITF W60 tournament in Canberra, Australia in March. She then lost against China's Yafan Wang in the Final of a second ITF W60 tournament in Canberra a week later.
- Won a round at the Australian Open before losing against Ukraine's Marta Kostyuk.
- Reaches the semi-finals of the Australian Open Mixes Doubles alongside partner Marc Polmans.

# DAN EVANS (GBR) v JAMES McCABE (USA)

### Head to Head: First meeting

### Dan Evans biography HERE

2023 highlights:

- Claimed wins against Italy's Matteo Arnaldi, Karen Khachanov and Argentina's Francisco Cerundolo before losing to Carlos Alcaraz in the semi-finals of the Barcelona Open.
- World No.11 Khachanov was the highest ranked player Evans has beaten this year, as he won <u>63 63</u> in Barcelona.
- Played for Great Britain in the Davis Cup win against Colombia in Cota on March.
- Won two rounds at the Australian Open before losing against world No.6 Andrey Rublev.

### James McCabe biography HERE

Career highlights:

- Played in two ATP Challenger semi-finals in Bengaluru, India, in February, losing to Australia's James Duckworth. He lost another semi-final against Yuta Shimizu in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, in March.
- Reached a career high ranking of No.277 in March 2023.
- Dan Evans is the highest ranked player McCabe has played in the professional ranks.

# LIAM BROADY (GBR) v GABRIEL DIALLO (CAN)

Head to Head: Broady leads 1-0

### **Previous meeting:**

2023 ATP Challenger, quarter-final in Biel, Switzerland (Indoor) - Broady won 36 75 63

## Liam Broady biography <u>HERE</u>

2023 highlights

- Broady kick-started March with a run to the quarter-final of the Lugano Challenger 75 where he just missed out on a spot in the semi-final to Dominic Stricker - losing 3-6, 6-3, 7-6(4).
- In February, Broady lifted his second ATP Challenger title after a dominant display at the Vilinus Open in Lithuania.
- Made it to the quarter-finals of the Canberra Challenger, having come through the qualifying rounds.
- Broady's biggest win of 2023 by ranking was against world No.113 Nikoloz Basilashvili in Doha in February.

### Gabriel Diallo biography HERE

2023 highlights:

- Won his first ATP Challenger title on home soil in Granby, Canada in August 2022.
- Played for Canada during their run to the 2022 Davis Cup title.
- Won an ITF M25 event in Montreal, Canada in March.
