Career highlights:

- Swan is aiming to make win her first ITF World Tennis Tour W100 final today.
- She has won 12 singles titles on the ITF World Tennis Tour two W60 (Lexington and Trnava in 2022, six W25 tournaments and two 15k events and two 10k tournaments.
- Her best ranking win of 2023 came against world No.69 Camila Giorgi in qualifying for the Lyon Open in January.
- She is the youngest player to represent Great Britain in the Billie Jean King Cup, playing against South Africa in 2016 aged 16 years and 316 days.
- Swan enjoys listening to music, baking, cooking, socialising with friends and spending time at home with her four dogs.
- Swan will become British No.1 for the first time in her career if she wins today's final.

Career highlights:

- Achieved a career high ranking of No.12 in April 2010, currently ranked No.140.
- Her best run in a Grand Slam event came at the 2009 US Open, where she reached the semi-finals and was beaten by Caroline Wozniacki.
- Her best run at Wimbledon was in 2011, when she reached the fourth round.
- Wickmayer has won two ITF World Tennis Tour titles this season, including W100 Trnava last month.
- In April 2021, Wickmayer gave birth to her first child, daughter Luana Daniëlla.
