Career highlights:

- Burrage played in her first WTA Tour final at the Rothesay Open Nottingham this month, losing against fellow Briton Katie Boulter.
- Burrage breezed through the opening two rounds at the W60 Croissy-Beaubourg event in April before facing Italy's Lucia Bronzetti in a bid for the title. In the final, Burrage overcame the Italian 36 64 60 to claim the fifth ITF singles title of her career and take her to a new career-high ranking of world No.109.
- Burrage started her 2023 off with a lengthy run to the final of the W60 Canberra event, where she lost out to fellow Brit, Katie Boulter 36 63 62.
- This is Burrage's fourth appearance in Eastbourne and her best run came last year, when she beat top seed Paula Badosa and reached the last-16.
- Her biggest ranking win of 2023 came against world No.21 Magda Linette in the last-16 of the Rothesay Open Nottingham.

Career highlights:

- Davis arrives in Eastbourne with a WTA ranking of No.44, with her career best being No.26 in May 2017.
- She has won two WTA Tour titles, the at the Aukland Open in New Zealand in 2017 and the
 most recent coming earlier this year in Hobart, Australia.
- Davis has won eight singles titles on the ITF World Tennis Tour, with the most recent coming in a W100 event in America in April 2019.
- This is her sixth appearance in Eastbourne and her best run came in 2014, as she came through qualifying and lost in the quarter-finals against America's Madison Keys.
- Her best rankings win of 2023 came against world No.32 Jil Teichmann in Dubai in February.
