GREAT BRITAIN STUDENTS TEAM

KNOW THE GAME

 There are specific game situations which are critical

 DATA can inform the 'norms' for these





KNOW THE GAME

- Matches rarely progress good, very good, great, game over.
- Matches are dynamic and momentum can build for one side or the other





KNOW THE GAME

- Matches develop and there are different phases which may require different responses
- Specific match events can become significant and matches can turn quickly





KNOW THE SCORE

- It brings you to a pinnacle when match events can take on significance (especially missed opportunities)
- You are required to start again regularly
- It allows for winning streaks
