FAQ's

When are fixtures played? Matches are played in the summer term. Match dates are scheduled by your local league organiser who will be in contact with you throughout. Year 8 & 10 regional dates are viewable online

Should I enter at Division 1 or Division 2? The majority of teams play in Division 2 at a localised level where matches take place in the summer term. Each division 2 winner will be invited to play in a Regional Finals Day in September or October where Division 2 winners from across the region will gather to compete in a one day tournament. Dates and venues will be available from 1 May 2018.

Stronger teams who feature students who are experienced tennis players should enter at Division 1 where they have a chance to reach Division 1 Regional and National finals that take place later in the year.
