PLAYER FIELD, DRAW SIZE, & FORMAT

Singles

Main Draw Men's & Women's 8 player draw size.

2 x Round Robin groups of 4 players, with top 2 players in each group progressing to knock-out semi-final

The 8-player field and invitations to play this event is as follows:

- -Player winning a Premier Tier event (Loughborough, Nottingham, West Worthing, Sutton) who is recognised by the ITF as playing under Great Britain.
- -The men's & women's winner of the Lexus British Tour Masters 2023.
- -The top 3 men and top 3 women on the Lexus British Tour leader board after the completion of Edgbaston (18-20 November 2024), with no requirement for minimum number of events played.
- -1 discretionary wild card from the LTA Performance Team.

If a wild card is not required, or invitation declined the next player on the leader board will be offered the place.

If players are on an equal number of points, positions are decided as follows:

- -Highest number tournaments played where points for leaderboard counted, then if still tied:
- -Highest number of points from one single tournament, then, if needed, the second and if still tied, then:
- -Drawn by lot

Invitations will be sent by email Friday 29 November, based on leader board positions after the final event at Edgbaston (18-20 November)

DRAW & SEEDING

The draw and match times will appear on the LTA web site www.lta.org.uk/britishtour & www.competitions.lta.org.uk

Seeding will be in order of ATP/WTA singles ranking, then ITF World Tennis singles ranking of 1500 or better, followed by ITF World Tennis Number (and then LTA open ranking if same WTN) at the time of making the draw.

It is the player's responsibility to check the time of their matches.

WITHDRAWALS

A player withdrawing after the draw has been made on Monday 9 December will incur LTA Withdrawal Points. All withdrawals need to be made through richard.joyner@lta.org.uk

In 'Finals' such as the Lexus British Tour Masters, where acceptance into the draw is decided by a player's position on the final leader board, seeding adjustments may take place **due to withdrawals after the draw has been made**. In this situation if the reserve moving in would have been seeded, then the seeding will be adjusted accordingly with the lowest seed being moved into the position in the draw of the player withdrawing.

However, if the withdrawal occurs after 8.00pm the day before play in this event starts, and the reserve would have been seeded, this reserve may not be brought in, and the next player on the reserve list will be invited where appropriate.

SCORING FORMAT All singles matches best of two tie-break sets and a match tie-break to 10 points as a

deciding set.
